Signs the “Whole Constitution Pledge”**

WASHINGTON, DC-- The National Senior Citizens Law Center is a signatory to the “Whole Constitution Pledge” and has joined *Constitutional Progressives*, a new coalition of progressive leaders, scholars, citizens, and organizations formed to reclaim the Constitution for the high ends it was designed to serve.

The U.S. Constitution was adopted by “We The People” of our nation, for purposes as enduring as the nation itself: “to form a more perfect Union, establish Justice, insure domestic Tranquility, provide for the common defence, promote the general Welfare, and secure the Blessings of Liberty to ourselves and our Posterity.”
